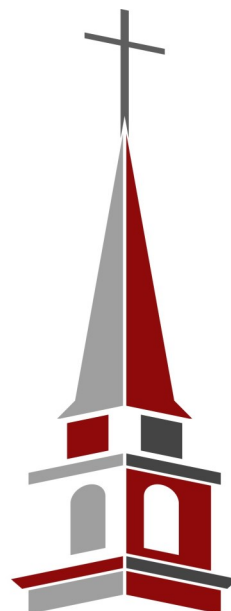

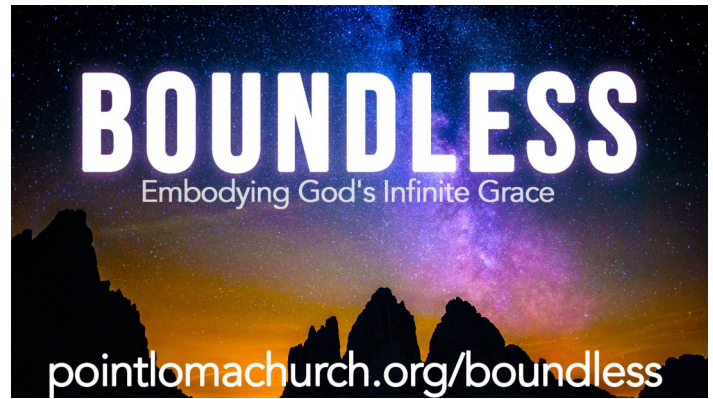
Session Meeting Highlights—November 17

It is Session's responsibility to "examine" each new class of elders- and deacons-elect prior to their ordination and installation. The deacon's class of 2024 was trained by Director of Community Life Evan Gratz, and had prepared statements of faith for Session review. The new deacons, all having previously served, were enthusiastically welcomed to their service by the Session, and will be ordained in January.

The Session Restructuring Committee led a deep and detailed discussion on their proposal for changing the Session's organization. Elder Lynn Ziegenfuss noted that this proposal is responding to the many changes that continue to develop since the pandemic onset, and that the Session should "get used to different." Elder John Brand noted that "the changes are designed to facilitate the Session elders to move from 'doing' to 'shepherding.'" The Session will continue the discussion in December.

Worship and Arts Chair Elder Chris Capen commented on the historic milestone achieved by the Online Ministry with the first-ever livestream of Bryan Verhoye's November 14 piano concert. Elders commented on how the new technologies enable many new opportunities for evangelism and congregational development.

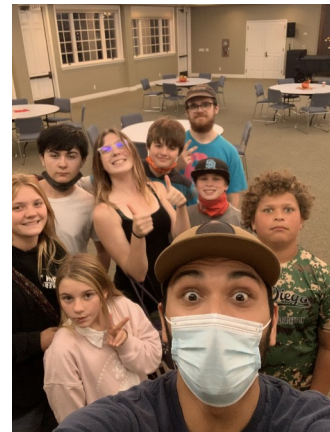

The Endowment and the End of the Year

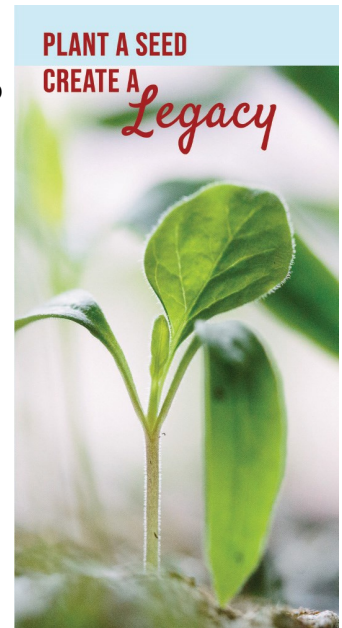

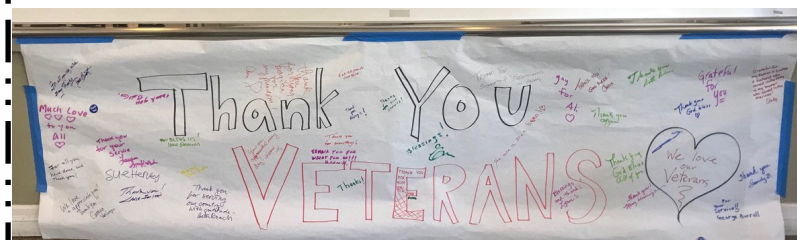
