This year, at the church, we have been exploring the boundless nature of God, particularly the boundlessness of God's love and grace.

The other day I was giving my three year old foster son a bath and, to my dismay, he dove under the water. At first I thought he had slipped, so in great panic, I reached in quickly to rescue him from drowning, but before I knew it, he was sitting up in the tub giggling, laughing, and splashing. I discovered he went under the water on purpose. He had so much fun the first time, he



decided to do it again, then again and again. Over and over, this little guy fully immersed himself in the bath water and came up to the surface with an explosion of joy. I couldn't help but smile and laugh along with him.

The exhibition of my foster son is how I imagine our lives would be if we fully immersed ourselves in our boundless God. Going under the water, just like going deeper with God, can be a daunting proposition. It can be scary to consider taking a leap of faith and trusting more, in the same way swimming must feel to a three year old who has not yet learned the skill. At the same time, the joy that follows the immersion is beyond compare.

## **Session Meeting Highlights—December 15**

The Session welcomed the elders-elect class of 2024 to the December meeting, and heard their statements of faith. Following some questions and answers, they unanimously voted to approve Jason Stevenor, Claudia Grauf-Grounds, Debbie Fountain, Rob Hannah, Katie Fulhurst and Cynthia Queen for three years of service on the Session. The Session will convene a special meeting to hear from elders-elect Jason Pritchett and Bob Lemke.


Other actions included the authorization of a contribution to the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance Fund for the midwest tornado victims, approval of the 2022 preliminary budget, and reactivation of the Renovation Task Force, with a new committee roster and funding from dedicated renovation funds.

The Session then discussed the proposal from the Session Restructuring Task Force on the reorganization of Session Committees into five "ministry teams." The Session acted to conditionally approve the plan, appoint a team that will build an implementation process, and then vote on final approval of the new structure after the implementation plan is approved. A plan description will be presented to the congregation soon.

The Session thanked Elders John Brand, Susan Cramer and Lynn Ziegenfuss for their faithful work on the restructuring plan and dissolved the Task Force with a prayer.

Pastor Karla concluded the meeting with thanks to the retiring elder's class of 2021: Max Butterfield, Mike Long, Rita Solberg, Frank Polese, and Barbett Wood, who has completed two consecutive terms.




