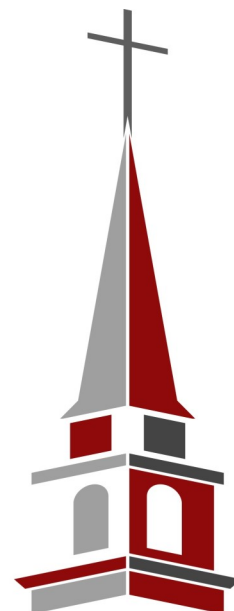

## Jen Weck Recognized by SDCOE



Congratulations to PLCPC member Jen Weck who was recently named the 2022 School Social Work Intern of the Year by the San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE). While serving as a substitute teacher, Jen realized that her true passion is in supporting students versus teaching them, so she enrolled in USC's master in social work program and began to truly change lives.

School social workers focus on supporting students' social and emotional health. For Jen, whose internship took her to the Monarch School, a K-12 school in Barrio Logan that serves children who are experiencing homelessness, she is certain that she is right where she is supposed to be.

In a Union-Tribune article about her, Jen said, "We know that they (the students at Monarch) are extremely capable ... but we also know that they come to school every day with a lot more baggage than the average student. That can make being successful at school difficult."

Supporting her students to be successful is a big motivator for Jen. She noted that while it is a big responsibility being that person for these kids, it is also very rewarding and encouraging to see them flourish as a result. No matter how big or small, we can all make an impact in our community. The key is to do something.

"The problem doesn't get any smaller by just thinking it's too big," Weck added. "The little things do matter. The little things do make a difference." We are so proud of Jen and all that she has learned. May we all learn from her as well!
