JOB DESCRIPTION

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to the following areas:

Programs and Events

- Plan, set up, and teach "Journey" a weekly ministry program for 4th & 5th graders every Monday, 4-5:30pm, during the school year. Includes planning of active games, curriculum lesson, and pizza dinner. *Modified Covid-19 protocol and schedule in effect until further notice.
- 2. Plan, set up, communicate, and execute fun quarterly events (ie., laser tag, bowling, movie night)
- 3. Coordinate and attend Winter Camp for one weekend each year
- 4. Track attendance for all programs
- 5. Help recruit volunteers to assist with program

Communication

1. Work with Director in creating regular e-blasts, and flyers to promote program and special events
