NEXT UP....

Although our campus is back open for ministry, we are also providing online only and hybrid options for anyone who would rather gather from a distance. If you do choose to return to campus, we ask that you be mindful of your own health, as well as previous contact with ill people before entering our communal spaces. We are proud to be an intergenerational community and we honor that by protecting those who are unable to receive the vaccine yet due to age or health conditions

While fully vaccinated individuals have a choice in wearing a mask on our campus, we strongly recommend everyone wear one while indoors. Masks are required for those who are not fully vaccinated and while working with our children and in our Preschool (regardless of vaccination status). Food and coffee service have also been reinstated, but safety protocols must be followed which include individually packaged goods or service by a person(s) wearing a mask and gloves.
